NOVICE AWARD

The Novice Award, which carries a prize of \$100, will be offered again at the 1955 meeting. The conditions are as follows:

1. A novice, for the purpose of this award, shall be a person who has not, as principal investigator, presented a paper before any national scientific group, nor shall he have published as a principal author a scientific paper in a journal of national circulation.

2. To be considered for the award, the novice must have a paper included in the general program of the 1955 meeting and must present the paper at that meeting.

3. The paper, to be considered for the Novice Award, must be the work of the one novice author, or of a group all of whom are novices. No subsequent publication of the paper shall be made under any other names than those of the person or persons presenting the paper at the meeting of the International Association for Dental Research.

4. After presentation, publication in the JOURNAL may be required.

5. These conditions are subject to change without notice.

6. The decision of the judges shall be final.

Authors who are eligible to compete for the Novice Award and wish to be considered for the award should state that fact in a note attached to the abstracts submitted to the program committee.
